- If you have a concern about a change to your body go to the doctor, don't wait!
- Report any changes in breast health immediately to a doctor, and remember that breast cancer affects both women and men.

# American Cancer Society's Role in Breast Cancer Research

Since 1971, the American Cancer Society has awarded approximately \$450.7 million in breast cancer research grants. Societyfunded research has led to the development of lifesaving breast cancer drugs such as tamoxifen and Herceptin, as well as discovery of genes linked to breast cancer (e.g., BRCA1)

Currently, there are 175 active research grants related to breast cancer totaling \$102.2 million. The majority of the Society's basic cancer research projects also have a potential benefit for breast cancer. In the 1970s, ACS funded research that found mammography was the best tool to find breast cancer early.

Cancer treatments have side effects and for more than 20 years the American Cancer Society Look Good...Feel Better program has helped cancer patients learn techniques to deal with those changes and feel better about their self-image. Last year, more than 500 Iowans benefited from this program. Trained American Cancer Society volunteers who are also breast cancer survivors provide one-on-one support to newly diagnosed patients through the Society's Reach to Recovery<sup>®</sup> program.
